

What is Adventure Guides?

A YMCA father-child program where dads (or father figures) and kids share monthly adventures, campouts, and activities. It's all about bonding, friendships, and unforgettable memories.

How is the program structured?

The Great Coastal Pacific Expedition includes families from Huntington Beach to San Clemente. Within our region, dads and kids join local Circles - often tied to schools or neighborhoods - such as the Knight Rangers, Free Willy, Mighty Buffalo, Bears, Pimu, and Wolf Pack.

What's the cost?

A one-time registration fee enrolls you in the program. Each event has its own cost, paid separately when registration opens (a few weeks before each event). Not ready for the season? Try a single trip with a Buddy Pass.

How much time does it take?

About one weekend event per month. Circles may also host optional gatherings. All events are beginner-friendly — no prior camping experience needed.

What kind of events are there?

Beach campouts, Catalina trips, sports overnights, fishing, campfires, and themed adventures — each designed for dads and kids to connect and grow together.
