What is Adventure Guides?

A YMCA father-child program where dads (or father figures) and kids share monthly adventures, campouts, and activities. It's about bonding, friendships, and memories.

Which circles are at St. Anne?

Most families join the Knight Rangers (father/son) or Avalon (father/daughter) circles. These are among the largest and most active in the program.

What's the cost?

A one-time registration fee enrolls you in the program. Each event has its own fee, paid separately when you sign up (registrations open a few weeks before each event). A Buddy Pass is also available to try a single event before committing.

How much time does it take?

On average, about one weekend event per month, plus optional circle get-togethers. Events are fully planned and beginner-friendly — no camping experience needed.

What kind of events are there?

Beach campouts, Catalina trips, sports overnights, fishing, campfires, and themed adventures — all designed for father-child bonding.

Adventure Guides is a school tradition. Dozens of dads and kids from St. Anne are already part of Knight Rangers and Avalon, making it easy to connect with classmates and their families.
